1 RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing - Windsurfing Competition Rules (WCR).
- 1.2 Special rules for Defiwind

2 ADVERTISING

Boards may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1 In planing situations, rail jibes, upwind tacking and sailing can be performed at a stable level.
- 3.2 Technical level equivalent to JWA badge level 2 for Japanese players.
- 3.3 Players who can compensate for self and third party compensation .
- 3.4 Minors must obtain the consent of a parent or guardian, and if youth athlete, the guardian must attend on the day of the event.

4 RACE FORMAT

- 4.1 Long distance in downwind. (Planned for 8–20km) ※Fan races may take place if wind speeds are not sufficient.

5 ENTRY FEES

- 5.1 The required entry fees are: 150 euro.
18,000 yen for Japanese players.

7 EQUIPMENT & EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 7.1 There are no restrictions on windsurfing.
However, the use of foil is prohibited.
- 7.2 There are no board and sale quantity limits.
When transporting equipment, the cost of bringing in equipment is handled individually by each player.

9 COMPLETION

1 race are required to be completed to constitute a series.

10 SAFETY

- 10.1 If personal buoyancy is prescribed every competitor shall wear a personal flotation device that shall conform to the minimum standard.
- 10.2 Personal buoyancy is mandatory for any competitors under 17 years of age.
- 10.3 A competitor shall personally sign for each board on the tally board system prepared in the regatta office before every time

she leaves the beach. Check-out will be accepted 40 minutes before the first scheduled warning signal of the day. When she leaves again after returning to the beach she shall also sign on the tally board system.

- 10.4 A competitor shall personally sign for each board on the tally board system prepared in the regatta office every time she returns there, except when temporary returning for recovery and so on. Check-in will be accepted no later than 45 minutes after the last board has finished the last race of the day. This period may be changed if the race committee so decides.
- 10.5 To participate in the race, you need to carry a GPS device prepared by the race office. When you return to the beach, you must return it.
- 10.6 The Race Committee may order retirement if it determines that the boat is unsailable or dangerous.
In addition, a player who needs rescue during a race may be forced to abandon equipment such as a board.

11 PRIZES

- 11.1 Prizes will be awarded to the first three competitors of each properly constituted class /division.
- 11.2 The class / division includes men's class, women's class, youth-junior class, techno class , and windsurfer class.

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk, see WCR 4 – Decision to Race. The organizing authority or any of their officials or representatives or the sponsors or their officials or representatives will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the event.

13 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions (SI' s) will be available upon

registration.

14 RACE AREA AND COURSES

The sea surface where the race will be held will be in the sea area around Yonaha Maehama Beach or the sea area around Yonaha Bay.

The race course will be announced at the skippers meeting on the day according to the conditions of the day.

15 FURTHER INFORMATION

- 15.1 Even if canceled due to weather conditions, the participation fee will not be refunded.
- 15.2 On the day, if a weather warning is issued, it will be canceled.
- 15.3 Follow the instructions of the operating staff.
- 15.4 Check your physical strength and physical condition of the day, and participate in your own judgment
- 15.5 Participants agree that names, affiliations, rankings, etc. may be posted on various media.
- 15.6 Participants shall automatically grant the Organizing Authority the permanent right to use, at their sole discretion, the production and use of videos, still photographs and video footage, recordings, films or prepresses during the event.
- 15.7 Prohibit dumping garbage.
